

Plagiarism Check Guidelines for PhD Thesis Submission

Plagiarism Policy

As per the UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (PROMOTION OF ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND PREVENTION OF PLAGIARISM IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS) REGULATIONS, 2018 following guidelines must be adhered to establish institutional mechanism to facilitate responsible conduct of research, promotion of academic integrity and deterrence from plagiarism.

Objectives:

- To create academic awareness about responsible conduct of research, study, project work, assignment, thesis, dissertation, promotion of academic integrity and prevention of misconduct including plagiarism in academic writing among students, researchers, faculty and other members of academic staff as well as any employee of university
- To develop systems to detect plagiarism and to set up mechanisms to prevent student, faculty, or staff of the University committing the act of plagiarism.

UGC Regulations for Plagiarism

Exclusion from Plagiarism while checking

The similarity checks for plagiarism shall exclude the following:

1. All quoted work either falling under public domain or reproduced with all necessary permission and or attribution.
 2. All references, bibliography, table of content, preface and acknowledgements.
 3. All small similarities of minor nature.
 4. All generic terms, laws, standard symbols and standards equations.
 5. Common knowledge or coincidental terms, up to fourteen (14) consecutive words.
- **Note: The research work carried out by the student, faculty, researcher and staff shall be based on original ideas, which shall include abstract, summary, hypothesis, observations, results, conclusions and recommendations only and shall not have any similarities.**

Authors are necessarily required to cite reference in case of any content adopted from anywhere other than internet open sites.

It is also that, even in case of open site internet source the copied contents if found more than 10% in aggregate during plagiarism detection, the work shall not be considered for further proceedings

Plagiarism Levels

Plagiarism would be quantified into following levels in ascending order of severity for the purpose of its definition:

| Sl.No | Level No. | Percentages of Similarity | Grade (Drill- Bit) |
|-------|-----------|--------------------------------------|------------------------------|
| 1 | 0 | Similarities up to 10% | Satisfactory -Grade A |
| 2 | 1 | Similarities above 10% to 40% | Upgrade- Grade B |
| 3 | 2 | Similarities above 40% to 60% | Poor - Grade C |
| 4 | 3 | Similarities above 60% | Unacceptable -Grade D |

Note: In parity with UGC Prevention of Plagiarism Regulations 2018, percentage below 10% would probably indicate that Plagiarism has not occurred.

Documents Necessary for Plagiarism Checking

- Application form for Plagiarism Checking (Annexure:i)
- Certificate on Plagiarism Check (Annexure: ii)
- Copy of fee receipt for Plagiarism check.
- CD should contain Core& Non core chapters in a separate file in PDF format.
- Separate file for Title page of Thesis (Transliteration Title for Regional languages)

Plagiarism Checking Chapters

Core Area means abstract, summary, hypothesis, observations, results, conclusion and and recommendations which are based on the original ideas of work carried out by the student , faculty, staff and researcher.

Non Core Area means all those parts of the thesis/dissertation that is included within the text that has sources from other original ideas that has to be paraphrased and the author and source to be acknowledged.

The Plagiarism CD should contain these two Chapters

“Core & Non-Core Area” in separate file in PDF format

1. Service available from 10.30 am to 4.00 pm.
2. Submit the application in the specified format duly signed by the Supervisor/Guide& Researcher. Applications without the signature & seal of the Supervisor & office seal shall not be accepted.
3. Fee for plagiarism checking is to be remitted to the concerned Department/ University Cash Counter and the copy of receipt to be attached along with the application.
4. Researchers are advised to submit the CD for plagiarism checking **7 days before** Thesis submission to the University.
5. Researchers should write Name,Department & Title of Thesis on the CD.
6. Certificate/Report on plagiarism check will be issued on the same day or next day of submission of completed application.
7. The Research Scholar must write the relevant information in the register in order to receive the certificate.
